Juan de Fuca Love

One of Rande Cook's new oval panels, *Juan de Fuca Love*, is another example of the richness and diversity of this Kwagwiltz artist's contemporary vision. He sandblasts the cedar, which brightens the grain, and transcends tradition by playing with a modern, colorful palette. Three additional panels—*Harbor Air*, *Lavender Fields* and *San Juan Current*, are also on display. Chief Rande Cook, born in Alert Bay on the northern tip of Vancouver, is passionate about passing along the strong values of life and culture learned from his extended family.



Susan Point's Latest Print

We are happy to present Susan Point's fourth serigraph in a series—*Musqueam Foreshore*. Point's series is inspired by a bird's-eye view of the Fraser River, an area that her Musqueam culture has been deeply connected to for thousands of years. "What I see are sandbars, and these change by re-braiding from season to season with the currents and the tides," she said. "The contours are revealed by salmon in the fore-ground, and incorporated within the delta theme are heron motifs."
